Privacy Statement

At Groosman we adhere to the current laws and regulations and we handle your personal details with care. We respect the privacy of visitors to our website.

What data do we process and why?

When you visit our website, we process some data for the technical management of the website. We only use cookies for our statistics. We also process technical data from the IP address of your device (with the last three digits not visible to us). All data is made anonymous. If you send us your personal data - such as first and last name, (e-mail) address and telephone number - to, for example, request information, register for an event or a newsletter, then we use the data for that purpose.

How is personal data collected?

Your personal data is collected through the use of the website and via the cookies that are placed on it. In addition, you can leave your details with us via the contact address on the website or by e-mail.

To whom do we provide personal data?

We sometimes engage third parties to carry out some of our business activities (such as mailing, printing, hosting and automation service providers). These third parties process the supplied data in accordance with the relevant laws and regulations.

We have a processing agreement with the relevant parties for this purpose.

How is the personal data we collect protected?

We handle your data with care. We have taken adequate technical and organisational measures to prevent misuse or the unlawful processing of the data. Think of an information security policy, employee training and secure servers. Our employees only have access to your personal data if this is necessary for them to carry out their work.

What is the storage period?

Unless legally required otherwise, we do not store the personal data of visitors to our website longer than necessary for the purpose for which we collect the data.

How can a subject access request be submitted?

You have the right to see, rectify or delete the personal data we have about you. You can request this via privacy@groosman.com. We will contact you as soon as possible to process your request. To ensure that the request has been made by you, we will ask you to identify yourself personally or to send us a copy of your proof of identity. In the case of the latter, we will ask you to make the passport photo and citizen service number (BSN) unreadable.

Everyone has the right to lodge an objection with the Dutch Data Protection Authority about our way of collecting and dealing with personal data.
